

Safety Recall

Free Upgrade Kit for Evenflo Triumph® Car Seats Manufactured Before November 1, 2005



Evenflo Company, Inc. will be offering a free upgrade kit to owners of certain Evenflo Triumph® car seat restraints manufactured before November 1, 2005. Evenflo discovered that portions of the cloth cover on Triumph models included in this recall can be pulled back, exposing the foam liner in an area that is reachable by the child occupant. A child inside the seat may break off and potentially choke on a piece of the foam liner.

This upgrade kit is only needed for Triumph® models manufactured before November 1, 2005 that have model numbers beginning with “264,” “359” or “389”. The kit is not needed for the Triumph® Advance™ or any Triumph® models manufactured on or after November 1, 2005. The model number and date of manufacture may be found on a white label on the lower, back side of the car seat restraint. The date is in month/day/year format. For example, MR2202 indicates a manufacturing date of March 22, 2002 and, therefore, such product would be included in this recall.
